Ordinances and Regulations for the
Degree of Bachelor of Arts (B.A) External
(As per Semester Pattern)
Effective from- June-2012

## O. Gen Arts (Ext.): 1

A candidate for the Degree of Bachelor of Arts (External) must have passed Higher Secondary School Certificate Examination of the Gujarat Secondary and Higher Secondary Education ( $12^{\text {th }}$ standard) Board or an examination recognized as equivalent thereto and will be required to pass six subsequent semester examinations for the Degree of Bachelor of Arts (External). Candidate fulfilling above requirements will be provisionally admitted in the First semester of B.A (External) Degree Programme.

## O. Gen. Arts (Ext.):- 2

B.A. External Degree Programme is of three academic years duration consisting of six semesters, which will be required to be completed within 6 year from the date of his/her admission in the First semester.

## O. Gen. Arts (Ext.):-3

Candidate register for the Sem.-1 (Ext.) can not join any other course of study without prior permission of the University.

## O. Gen. Arts (Ext.):- 4

Examination shall be either English, or Hindi or Gujarati as the case may be and the same will not be changed during the entire Degree programme.

## O. Gen. Arts (Ext.)- 5

Admission granted to any student shall be provisional till the registration certificate is issued and in case of admission is granted provisionally to the candidate of recognized University, the conditions \& instruction given by the University should be complied within the time limit fixed by the University.

## O. Gen. Arts (Ext.)- 6

A Candidate of this or any other University recognized by A.I.U. who has passed the examination of F.Y. under Annual pattern of the Faculty of Arts by obtaining at least $40 \%$ Marks or equivalent grade, shall be entitled to be admitted in Semester-III provided subjects passed by the candidate are same or comparable/convertible in force at the time \& such admission.His/her class will be awarded on the basis of marks obtained in sem. III to VI by concern candidate.

## O. Arts (Ext.): 1

There will be two streams of course leading to the Degree of Bachelor of Arts External (1) English Course and (2) Non-English Course. The candidate may be admitted to any of the stream irrespective of the subject which was offered by the candidate at the H.S.C. ( $12^{\text {th }}$ std.) or equivalent examination. The candidate will not be allowed to change the stream ones he has opted for it.

## O. $\operatorname{Arts}($ Ext.):- 2

A candidate who has already passed B.A. External Degree Examination with one Core subject may re-appear for B.A.External Degree Examination by opting with another one of the elective subjects as a core subject by observing following provisions.

## Provisions:-

1. A candidate will have to choose his one of the elective subject as core subject for his Re-appearance in B.A.(External)Degree Programme and
(A) $1 \mathrm{He} /$ she will has to appear in semester -III and IV Semester End Examination for the paper which he/she have not appeared at his/her initial or previous appearance in semester- III and IV Examination by applying and paying University Examination and Registration fees..
(A) 2. Such candidates can Reappear in semester- III \& IV University Semester End Examination only after he/she has obtained registration in semester -V and VI respectively. A Candidate has to appear in (i) Foundation course and (ii) Six core courses of semester V \& VI in order to obtain class.
(A) 3. The result of the semester -V \& VI will not be declared unless the candidate has obtained minimum marks for passing in remaining papers of semester -III to VI examination.

## O. Arts (Ext.)- 3

A Candidate who has passed First year B.A. examination from other recognized University by obtaining at least $40 \%$ of marks or equivalent Grade and where CBCS semester system is not made applicable may be admitted in Semester III. Provided the subjects passed by the candidate is comparable / convertible with our teaching \& examination Scheme in force at the time of admission.

When such admission to External examination is granted to a candidate all applicable Ordinances \& Regulation shall be applied to such a candidate.

## O. Arts (Ext.):- 4

A candidate who has passed F.Y. B. A. (Regular) examination of this University shall be eligible for admission in B. A. (External) semester - III provided he/she has appeared as whole examination candidate and obtained at the $40 \%$ or more marks in F.Y.B.A. (Regular) examination candidate will be required to submit Transfer Certificate from the college from which he has passed F.Y. B.A. (Regular) examination.

## O. Arts (Ext.):-5

If a candidate at an University Semester Examination fails to obtain minimum marks for passing in particular course (subject) he/she will be required to reappear in that course (subject). The candidate will have to reappear in the semester examination by paying fresh examination \& registration fees. When he/she obtains minimum or more than minimum marks for passing the course, his/her marks of reappearance will be carry forwarded for determining the class.

## O. Arts (Ext.):- 6

To successfully complete a course, candidate will be required to obtain minimum 06 out of 30 mark in two home assignment as well as 28 out of 70 marks in external examination to be taken by the University and should have also obtained $40 \%$ of marks in aggregate in each of the course.

## R. Arts (Ext.):-1

Candidate must forward their applications for registration to the University examination to the Controller of examination on or before the prescribed date along with the registration fees.

## R. Arts (Ext.): 2

## : Admission to higher Semester :

A candidate duly admitted in semester-I external examination shall be eligible for admission up to semester IV, provided he/she gradually appears in home assignment and external components of the examination of Semester II, III, \& IV. In case of admission to Semester V external examination. The candidate should have cleared all the courses of at least Three Semesters out of four Semester referred above. A candidate shall be eligible for admission to semester $\mathrm{VI}^{\text {th }}$ examination without any backlog of semester I to IV and has appeared in assignment \& external University examination of Semester $\mathrm{V}^{\text {th }}$.

The result of semester $\mathrm{VI}^{\text {th }}$ external examination will be declared only when he/she have cleared all the courses of semester I to V.

## R. Arts (Ext.):-3

A Candidate proceeding for the programme leading to the Degree of Bachelor of Arts (External) shall be required to offer Courses throughout semester I to VI as follows.

Each theory course shall carry 100 Marks ( 30 marks for home assignment and 70 marks for University examination).The theory examination having maximum 70 marks, shall be of three hours of duration or as decided by the University.

## R. Arts (Ext.):-4

## R. Arts (Ext.).- 5

The evaluation process is divided into two parts. The first part-consists of home assignment and the second part consists of the Semester Examination to be conducted by the University.

## R.Arts (Ext.). - 6

To successfully complete a course, candidate will be required to obtain minimum 06 out of 30 mark in two home assignment as well as 28 out of 70 marks in external examination to be taken by the University and should have also obtained $40 \%$ of marks in aggregate in each of the course.A statement of marks will be issued to the candidate indicating whether a candidate has successfully completed semesterI , II, III, IV or V (as the case may be) and on successful completion of all six semester candidate will be issued a statement of marks indicating total marks obtained and class awarded to him.
