Faculty of Arts Ordinances & Regulations for the Degree of Master of Arts (M. A.) External (As per Semester Pattern)

Effective from June - 2012

<u>O. M.A.(Ext.) – 1</u>

A candidate who has passed Bachelor of Arts three years Degree Examination by offering appropriate core (special) subject from this University or any other examination recognized as equivalent thereto shall be entitle to apply for admission to Master of Arts (External) Degree Programme.

<u>O. M.A. (Ext.) – 2</u>

M. A. External Degree programme is of Two Academic Years duration consisting of four semesters, which will be required to complete within 4 years from the date of his/her first registration in the First Semester.

<u>O. M.A. (Ext.) – 3</u>

A candidate registered (for M.A. Ext.) can not join any other course of study without prior permission of the University.

<u>O. M.A. (Ext.) – 4</u>

Medium of Examination shall be English or Gujarati (as the case may be) which will not be changed during the entire Degree Programme.

<u>O. M.A. (Ext.) – 5</u>

If a candidate appearing in the University Semester Examination and fails to obtain minimum marks for passing in particular course he/she will be require to reappear in that course. The candidate will have to reappear in the semester examination by paying fresh examination & registration fees along with an application form. Such a candidate when obtains minimum or more than minimum marks for passing in the course his/her marks of reappearance will be carry forwarded for award of class.

<u>O. M.A. (Ext.) – 6</u>

A Candidate of this or any other University recognized by A.I.U. who has passed the examination of B.A.Degree under Annual pattern of the Faculty of Arts by obtaining at least 40% Marks or equivalent grade, shall be entitled to be admitted in Semester-I in case of candidate migrated from other University subjects passed by the candidate are same or comparable/convertible in force at the time & such admission.

Registration granted to any student shall be provisional till the registration letter is issued by the University & in case of admission is granted provisionally, the conditions & instruction given by the University should be complied within the time limit fixed by the University or latest by the beginning of next semester otherwise term kept by the such a student will be forfeited and no fees on any account will be refunded.

<u>**R. M.A. (Ext.)** – 1</u>

The examination will comprise of the following Special (Core) subject and a candidate will be require to select one on the bases of his/her special subject at Graduation examination.

The evaluation process is divided into two parts. The first part-consists of home assignment and the second part consists of the Semester Examination to be conducted by the University. The weightage of marks for home assignment is 30 marks and for external University examination is 70 marks. A Candidate has to obtain minimum 40% in (i.e. 12 out of 30 and 28 out of 70 Marks in each of the component separately).

<u>R. M. A. (Ext.) -4</u>

Candidates must forward their applications for admission to University external examination to the Controller of examination on or before the prescribed date with necessary document require for registration and fees for examination and registration.

<u>R. M. A. (Ext.) -5</u>

To successfully complete a course, candidate will be required to obtain minimum 12 out of 30 mark in two home assignment as well as 28 out of 70 marks in external University examination in each of the course. A statement of marks will be issued to the student indicating whether a candidate has successfully completed semester- I, II, III(as the case may be) and on successful completion of IVth semester candidate will be issued a statement of marks indicating total marks obtained and class awarded to him.
